**HARRIS CONTINUES TO BE A STRONG VOICE FOR THE

New NSW Labor Leader Chris Minns yesterday announced his new Shadow Cabinet line-up to challenge for government at the 2023 NSW State election.

"I have always been a strong advocate for the Central Coast being recognised for its unique economic, social and environmental features and I look forward to working closely with local organisations to develop a sustainable future pathway to prosperity which benefits our community," Mr Harris said

"New NSW Labor Leader Chris Minns has made it clear he wants to be seen as a credible alternate government which is focused on solutions to improve the lives of

people and I'm very much committed to being part of that team and that agenda," Mr Harris said
